Current control measures.	<p>Instructor must always be in a position where they can hold the dead rope if the group belay.</p> <p>Instructor <b>must</b> be holding the dead rope if a group member is belaying on their own.</p> <p>The belayer should be of similar weight to the climber, or be backed up by a ground anchor, or assist in a suitable manner.</p>
