



Conditions of use for Archery

1. Activities on the Archery Range must be directly supervised by someone who holds the Grand National Archery Society Leaders Award, or a further GNAS award.
2. Leaders may supervise a maximum of 12 participants.
3. Participants must always keep the bow and arrow pointing down the range.
4. Participants must not cross the shooting line until everyone has finished shooting AND the instructor has told them it is safe to do so.
5. When participants retrieve the arrows they must collect all arrows and carry them back to the shooting line in a safe manner.
6. Never dry shoot a bow without an arrow attached to the string, as it damages the bow. Never shoot upwards.
7. Participants not shooting must wait behind the waiting line.
8. Leaders must inform the office of any lost equipment and return any broken equipment to the office.
9. Employees of Girlguiding UK may suggest or insist on alternative techniques or styles.
10. Girlguiding UK accepts no responsibility for damage or injury resulting from use of the range unless proven negligent .
