



Conditions of use for the Rifle Range

1. Activities in the Rifle Range must be directly supervised by someone who holds one of the following:
 - National Smallbore Rifle Association Youth Proficiency Tutor's Diploma
 - Gun Club Instructor Certificate
 - experience gained instructing at a rifle or pistol club or through association with the armed forces (must be over 21 years of age).
2. Anyone who has been sentenced to any form of detention or corrective training may not take part.
3. The guns must not leave the range under any circumstances.
4. Eye protection must be worn at all times when firing is taking place by **all** those in the range.
5. When not in use, guns are to have their barrels broken.
6. When guns are being loaded they are to be pointed towards the targets and remain so until they are discharged.
7. The supervising adult may only collect the target once all guns have their barrels broken and are resting on the counter.
8. The door to the range should be kept closed at all times.
9. Any damaged or missing equipment must immediately be reported to the office.
10. Employees of Girlguiding UK may suggest or insist on alternative techniques or styles.
11. Girlguiding UK accepts no responsibility for damage or injury resulting from use of the range unless proven negligent.
